Executive Summary

OpenSummit.AI is Australia's largest agentic AI convention, scheduled for 22 April 2026 in Southbank, Melbourne. The convention is closely associated with OpenClaw, one of the fastest-growing open-source AI agent projects globally, which has attracted over 310,000 GitHub stars and a vibrant developer community. OpenSummit.AI serves as a nexus point for the Australian agentic AI ecosystem, bringing together practitioners who are actively building and deploying autonomous AI systems across industries including healthcare, finance, mining, e-commerce, and professional services.

The event operates on an exclusivity model—there are no recordings or livestreams available, creating urgency and emphasizing the value of in-person attendance. With tickets starting at \$145 AUD and a 3.5-hour format, the convention is designed to be accessible to small business owners while delivering concentrated, actionable content.

Event Overview

OpenSummit.AI describes itself as "Australia's largest agentic AI convention" with a focus on practical AI deployment for business. The event targets business owners and leaders who want to implement AI

in their companies, explicitly noting that attendees do not need coding skills to benefit from the content.

Understanding OpenClaw

OpenSummit.AI is branded as "Australia's Largest Agentic / OpenClaw AI Convention," establishing a direct connection to the OpenClaw open-source project. OpenClaw is a personal AI assistant framework created by Austrian developer Peter Steinberger in November 2025. The project has experienced explosive growth, becoming one of the fastest-growing open-source AI projects in history.

OpenClaw Capabilities

OpenClaw enables users to run autonomous AI agents on their own devices (Mac, Windows, or Linux) that can execute real tasks including: - Managing files and controlling browsers - Sending messages across multiple platforms - Automating workflows - Smart home control and IoT integration - Calendar and email management - Code deployment and DevOps automation

The project operates on a model-agnostic architecture, supporting Anthropic Claude, OpenAI GPT models, and local models via Ollama. This flexibility allows users to choose their preferred AI provider while maintaining data privacy.

Industry Recognition and Concerns

OpenClaw has attracted significant attention from both technology enthusiasts and security researchers. According to Xinhua reporting on ClawCon (the first major OpenClaw community gathering), the project drew participants from Europe, North America, and elsewhere. However, cybersecurity companies have raised concerns—Cisco research materials reportedly described OpenClaw as "an absolute nightmare" from a security perspective despite being groundbreaking in capability, and CrowdStrike advised organizations to treat any OpenClaw installation on work devices as a potential security incident.
